



Analysing Maps

Evaluate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What new aspects of the respective historical event does/do the map(s) reveal to you? • Can you find any potential of historical change or conflict on the map(s) and what might the outcome be like? • What information do you miss on the map(s)?
